NORTHSTAR NEW JERSEY'S AFTER SCHOOL ADVANTAGE PROGRAM INSTALLS \$15,000 COMPUTER LAB AT THE SALVATION ARMY'S BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF THE IRONBOUND IN NEWARK
